In a year of a pandemic it is hard to believe that there will be a multi sport event in a years time in Regina. Hopefully things go well between now and then and our young skaters 11 to 14 years old as of December 31, 2021 can compete against the top skaters from around the province in a very cool event. The Regina club and SASSA are busy working with the Saskatchewan Games Council to be ready for Feb. 20, 2022.

Here are a few details that you will need to know about the Games.

### **Technical package/eligibility**

Athletes must be 11 to 14 years of age. Skaters must be no more than 14 years of age by December 31, 2021 and must be 11 years of age before February 1, 2022.

### **Travel**

Each district arranges bus transportation to Regina. Details to follow.

### **Accommodation**

Coaches, managers and athletes will stay in dorm style accommodation. Details to follow.

### **Districts**

Each district is allowed eight athletes, four female and four male. If there are districts that don't send A full team those empty spots are split between the other districts. Districts wanting fill spots will provide a list to the technical chair (Tim). Most years, many districts send more than eight athletes to the Games. Fill athletes can be awarded metals but they don't count for points.
